



Itinerary

FEB 16 - Jan and James will arrive early to get extra supplies, store some crates, and to get things ready for the group arrival.

FEB 17 - Jan and James will meet the group with our guides on arrival in Nairobi and transfer to Fairview (B,L) Note: James and I find ourselves hungry after the plane ride as the last dinner tends to be small. The restaurant is generally open but payment will be on your own.

FEB 18 - Drive to Ol Pejeta. About 4 hours. Arrive for check in and lunch. Afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight Sweetwaters Serena Tented Camp (BLD)

FEB 19-27 (9 NIGHTS AT SWEETWATERS) - Box breakfast for full day Ol Pejeta with morning and afternoon game drives with a lunch break at the camp or all day game viewing with picnic lunch. Dinners and overnights Sweetwaters Serena Tented Camp (BLD)

FEB 28 - Morning game drive with boxed breakfast - or stay in and pack as desired. Lunch. (BL) Drive back to Nairobi.

4:00 Pm Arrive for a farewell early dinner at the Carnivore Restaurant with your guides. Jan, James and two other guests will be leaving by bushplane for the Mara Extension directly from the Nanukui air strip.

6:00 followed by onwards transfer to Jomo Kenyatta Airport for your international flight. Note: It will seem that you are getting to the airport very early, but lines can be VERY long. You must fill out immigration departure forms and in general it is necessary to get there early. Once through security there are restaurants and bars. Don't rush into your gate area. They are screened and secured so you can't easily leave to get something to drink or eat or go to the restroom. There is a bar/restaurant right near the gate. Just be patient - they will start calling the gate VERY early, and if you don't want to sit in a hot stifling packed room for hours, best to wait a bit....
